Originally from Kerry, Ireland, Florry attended university in Dublin, where he completed a physiology degree and a master's in neuroscience alongside his medical studies. In 2010, he moved to New Zealand and went on to complete advanced training in palliative medicine and older people's health. Over the past two years, Florry has worked as a locum across New Zealand and Australia and he is currently based at St George Hospital in Sydney.
