Sarah is the Clinical Nurse Specialist for the Patient at Risk (PAR) service at Wellington Hospital. She is deeply passionate about patient safety, with a strong focus on early recognition and rapid response. Sarah has worked closely with whānau and consumers to co-design the family escalation pathway Kōrero Mai — an experience she describes as both humbling and a privilege.

She is an active member of the NZCCOF committee, contributing to the development of national standards for outreach services, and serves on the Advisory Committee for the International Society for Rapid Response Systems (iSRRS).

In this session, Sarah will present the Quality and Operational Standards for the Provision of Critical Care Outreach Services. She will outline key components of the standards, share practical steps for implementation and improvement, and highlight best practice examples that show how these frameworks can enhance patient outcomes and drive consistent, high-quality outreach care.
