Topics covered will include recognising deterioration, bedside nursing interventions, and escalating respiratory-based therapies (both non-invasive & invasive).

Toni is currently the only NP working inside an ICU within NZ, and is part of the RMO clinical roster responsible for triaging referrals & attending in-hospital patient emergencies.
