This webinar explores perinatal palliative care and the care of pēpē and whānau facing life-limiting diagnoses during pregnancy, birth or the neonatal period. We will consider who the families we meet are, how palliative care is integrated within Neonatal Intensive Care, and where else this care can be delivered. Through case discussions, participants will reflect on practical challenges, and opportunities to improve culturally responsive, compassionate care and outcomes for whānau

Dr Callum Gately is a Neonatal Intensive Care Consultant at Wellington Hospital, specialising in perinatal, medical and surgical intensive care. A graduate of Otago University (2008), he previously held a Consultant role at Mater Neonatal Critical Care Unit in Brisbane before joining Wellington Hospital in 2021. Alongside intensive care delivery, he has a strong interest in perinatal palliative care and works with a team of nursing champions providing exceptional care in this under-resourced space.
