Gynaecological cancers are the fifth most common site of cancer in Aotearoa New Zealand and the fourth cause of cancer mortality in women. Our guest presenter, Associate Professor Peter Sykes will outline recent changes with regard to incidence, approaches to detection, and management of gynaecological cancers.

Topics to be covered include:

- Ovarian cancer diagnosis treatment and outcomes
- Endometrial cancer increasing incidence and change in management
- Cervical cancer HPV screening and its impact and vaccination
- Vulval cancer management

Peter completed his undergraduate training in the United Kingdom and specialised in Obstetrics and Gynaecology in New Zealand. He subsequently completed his sub-specialty training in gynaecological oncology in Melbourne and his interests include gynaecological oncology and advanced preinvasive disease of the genital tract. He was the recent lead investigator on the Lets Test for HPV implementation trial and prior lead investigator of cervical cancer screening history reviews.
