Nicola achieved Nurse Practitioner status in 2019. Her work includes screening, assessing and diagnosing people with chronic respiratory and related conditions, prescribing and managing treatment and follow up. Nicola has been involved in running an outpatient service for people with a variety of conditions requiring non-invasive ventilation since 2007. Nicola was the nursing representative on the COPD EAG for the Ministry of Health and part of the team who have developed the first national COPD guidelines. Nicola is on the NZ Asthma and Respiratory foundation, NZ Scientific Advisory Board and Vaping expert advisory boards.
